ALDA MICRO EVENT MOSTAR 4-8 SEPTEMBER 2017

ALDA MICRO EVENT IN MOSTAR, BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA will take place from 4-8 SEPTEMBER 2017, with the main focus on THE NEW HOPES for the new urban generation in the city that had gone through a vast destruction in 1993 during the war conflict in the Balkans.

The main goal of this cultural venture is to inspire innovative and “beyond the box” thinking of social community theatre engagement in an ethnically divided city. The events are aimed to encourage citizens of all ages from different ethnic and religious background and from diverse walks of life to participate in seeking common creative solutions for social engagement in public space all across the city. MOSTAR itself is perceived as the city of plenty of hidden talents, natural and intellectual resources and as such will be playing an important role in this Caravan next micro event. Both the “Old Bridge”, the Neretva river, the Clock Tower, the Spanish Square, Old Tombstones, Blagaj or the sounds of old Mostar sevdah music, each with their rich historic narrative will make this micro event a unique cultural and learning experience.

Therefore the five days programme of this intercultural festival of social teathre are dedicated to the historic and cultural narrative of city of Mostar and its citizens, the history, the present and the future. Our main topics are: **The Culture of Remembrance, Patchwork Mostar, Mostar shared public and cultural spaces, My City – Youth City, Mostar sevdah.** A wide range of social community theatre tools will be employed to animate local youth groups, cultural and educational institutions, civil society organisations, local policy and decision makers.

Our main partners in organising the event in Mostar are local civil society organisation **Local Democracy Agency Mostar** (www.ldamostar.org) and **Mostar Youth Theatre** led by **Sead Djulic, the theatre director and pedagogue.**
